Covid-19 testing

Home testing kits

Alongside the rollout of the vaccine, regular testing is going to be an essential part of the easing of restrictions.

To assist with this, West Lancs Borough Council is offering a community collect scheme which will operate from all of the current Asymptomatic testing sites during their opening hours, allowing members of the public to access home testing kits which they can carry out twice weekly in the privacy of their own home. You can also attend any of the Asymptomatic testing sites for a supervised test.
