What we're up to (and where)

- £97,000 secured (contracts pending) from Community Energy Fund (CEF) for stage two development study, following stage one in 2022/2003 under Rural CEF
- Two specialist firms (wind and solar/low carbon) retained to develop specifications and business plan
- Project managed by SWLICAN
- Formation of Community Benefit Society planned, with FCA approval to raise 'community shares'
- Mix of existing technologies and innovation esp related to a) ambient loop technology; b) household metering and billing
- And the sites......

- Precise interface between stages 1 and 2 (incl. emerging Net Zero)
- Future geographies and land ownership

- Climate Action Fund (Our Shared Future) stage one
- £1.5m over 3-5 years
- Due 'Spring 2025'
- 'Formal partnership' requirement
